We welcome today Reverend A. Gordon Johnson and his wife, Pastor Marie. Pastor Johnson was born in Albert Lea, Minnesota, where he graduated from Albert Lea Senior High School and then St. Olaf College. He was commissioned as an officer and served in the US Air Force as a pilot for ten years. He attended Luther Theological Seminary in St Paul, MN and was ordained in 1968, returning to duty in the Air Force as a chaplain. Assignments included Japan, Germany, Alaska and numerous stateside bases. Following retirement in 1984, he served as lead pastor at Central Lutheran Church, Spokane, WA, then as EWA-ID Synod interim pastor for five years before being called to Resurrection Lutheran Church, Juneau, AK. He was Executive Director of Catholic Charities in Juneau when called to serve as pastor pilot and Executive Director of Lutheran Association of Missionaries and Pilots (LAMP) in Canada, serving as pastor/mentor for native communities for five years. Married to Reverend Marie-Claude Herrenschmidt in 2001, they were called to a 4- congregation parish in northern Montana for four years, retiring in 2007. Living in Granbury, TX for 14 years they served interim ministry several times before moving to Liberty, SC at the invitation of his youngest daughter and her husband. Pastor Johnson and Pastor Herrenschmidt are currently members of University Lutheran Church in Clemson.

Pastor Fischer will be returning from vacation and will be back in the office on Tuesday morning.
