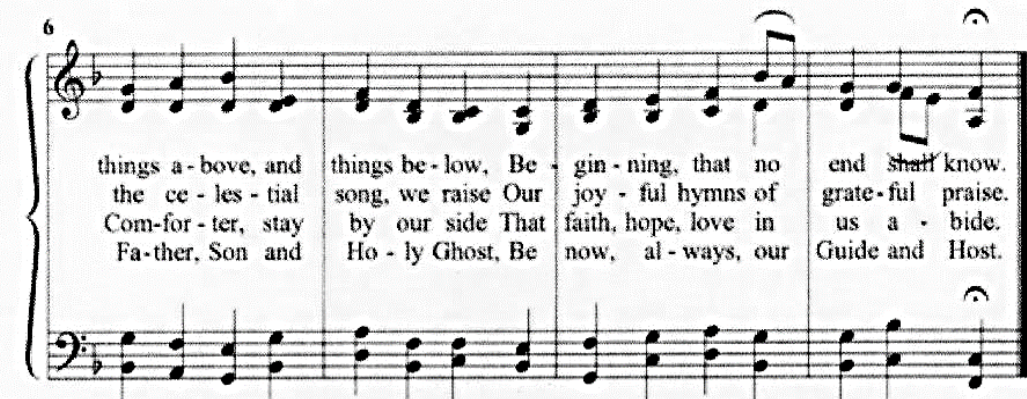
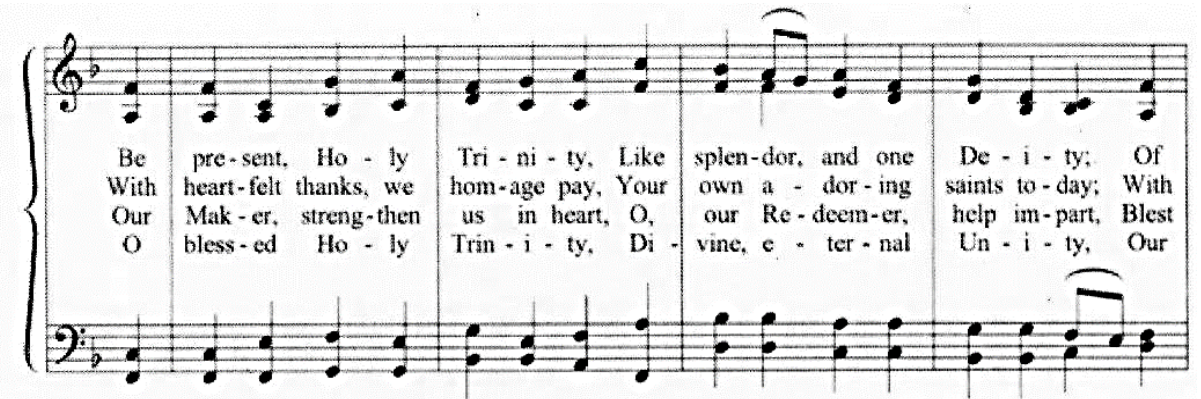

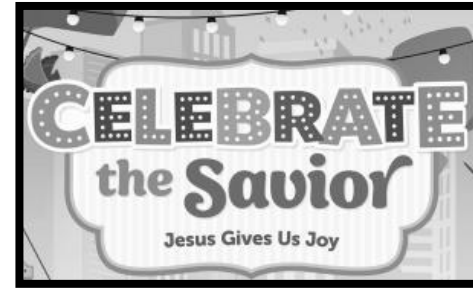
Vacation Bible School
