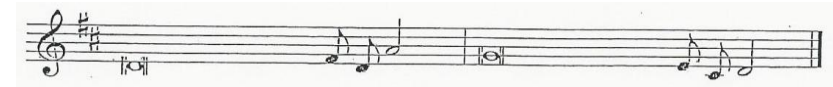
Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another. (we kneel)
